

PARISH of MOULTON

9 FOOTPATHS and 1 BRIDLEPATH

- FP1 from Newmarket Road (Ashley Heath Stud entrance) to Cheveley Road
(Note: much of this path follows the Suffolk-Cambridgeshire border,
crossing into Ashley Parish after the stile)
- FP2 from School Road, past Trinity Hall Cottages, to Kennett Road
- FP3 from Lark Hill, behind Maltings Close, to The Street
- FP4 from the ford near St. Peter's Church, along the west side of the
River Kennett, to Kennett Road
- FP5 from The Street (opp. FP3) over three stiles across the meadow
to The Pretty Bridge (small flint footbridge over the river)
- FP6 from the stile out of the churchyard, past Filberry Stables
to Gazeley Road (opp. water pumping station)
- FP7 from the stile out of the churchyard, over two more stiles and across
the field to Gazeley Road
- FP8 from FP7 after the second stile, down the east side of the hedge,
to Gazeley Road (near Primrose Hill Farm entrance)
- FP11 from Cheveley Road to Mill Road, Ashley
(Note: part of this path follows the Suffolk-Cambridgeshire border)
- BR14 BRIDLEWAY from St. Peter's Church gate southeast towards Dalham
(Note: this bridlepath crosses the Moulton-Dalham Parish boundary
at the wooden fence by the steep drop into the river)
